Dear Sir or Madame:

I learned on today that Congressman Mr. Sandford Bishop office will not be preparing a Letter of Support in response to a \$4,000 October 2020 grant request. I had intended to use the funds to further develop my service-oriented business as well as contributed to the drafting of Federal acts. I do know that Congress and the White House partners with unpaid, volunteer Pages/Interns, however I seek the grant to provide compensation for such a complex undertaking.

Recently I clarified Initiative 9 of 60 in order to state that the Federal Reserve and U.S. government be compelled to implement within several phases legislation, revisions to statute or C.F.R. in order to mandate a nationwide paper recycling program; unsoiled paper refuse would be taken to the Federal Reserve's above-ground vaults or other reasonable facilities where solvents would be used to break down and reconstitute the material for the production of currency. These Phases, listed below in 7 pages, will cure the cash shortages and dependence on borrowing in order to finance the United States' 4 million employees as well as entitlements SSI/SSDI.

Please know that I learned that the IRS purges records every three years--essentially every year.

Furthermore, it is my hope that the Federal Reserve and Treasury will prohibit 'away bank' mortgage/credit refinancing wherein a mortgage or credit card consumer, after completing papers, wastefully extracts cash from the Federal Reserve in order to pay off the principal of an earlier mortgage or credit balance. Instead, I propose that with monitoring from the Federal Reserve, that the original lender be lawfully mandated to lower the interest rate of its loan.

The United States must be funded by its own resources instead of proceeding onward in its current fashion of dependence on foreign sources of cash.

Congressman Bishop and Congresswoman Williams:

I am writing concerning an October 2020 \$4,000 grant request; I composed 60 initiatives by March 2021 that were sent to the White House in order to assist in the formulation of Legislation. Although I was born in Albany, Georgia I am a registered voter of Fulton County. Please contact me by telephone before making this grant to the name of FreedomTree Asset Management.

Initiative 9 - This initiative recommended federally mandated recycling of metals, plastics, paper and Styrofoam. With regard to the recent cash shortage and budget shortfalls I would like to at this time clarify my statements. This nationwide recycling effort should come in Phases 1 , Phase 2 and Phases 3.

Phase 1: Please ratify Legislation mandating that all United States government branches--Congress, the Executive

and Judicial Branches transport paper scraps to the Federal Reserve's system of above-ground printing presses and vaults.

Phase 2: Subsequently a list should be compiled containing the contact mailing address for all businesses having a Tax Identification Number. In an orderly and organized fashion businesses small and large--by number of employees--must return, unsoiled paper to their bank's branches.

Phase 3: In the coming months I hope that citizens and countrymen and women will bring their unneeded paper goods to their local bank branches for transport to the Federal Reserve.

Phase 4: All of America's land fields must be opened and all recyclable material sorted and reused.

Phase 5: Monies from mortgage brokers should be set aside for farm grants and loans to made for the cultivation of

Peanuts whose shell is a necessary paper composite.

Mr. Biden:

I have recomposed the following initiatives that I hope your administration will implement, and special thanks to fmr. First Lady Michelle Obama for reminding us all of the notion of the White House initiative.

Also please know that I eagerly await the 2020 grant request of \$4,000, which should be preceded by a telephone call to 912 675 3817.

Initiative 1 - White House Rebuild - construct an all steel, nuclear-ready fortified White House.

Initiative 2 - Lost Parcel Service - to encourage commerce and spur profits, please direct the United States Postal Service to devise a feasible solution to lost and misdirected mail and packages. Presently several parcels are being returned to sender, including to myself and another federal office with which I regularly communicate. See attached letter dated April 26, 2021.

[REVISED] Initiative 3 - Pensions for USA - Private sector corporations must receive funding by way of investment bankers in order to offer federally-insured pensions. The expanded health care benefit must not be the extent of federal legislation with regard to individual financial products. If this can not be implemented, in lieu of all private corporations providing pensions it is my hope that the SSI pays a minimum of \$2,000 monthly.

Initiative 4 - FDIC expanded - The FDIC must operate a physical office in one to five cities in each state to facilitate claims in the event of bank failure.

Initiative 5 - No Death Penalty - Mr. Biden please place a moratorium on the death penalty until an executive branch agency is able to provide added oversight to failures in Due Process.

[REVISED] Initiative 6 - 80% reduction in table sugar (sucrose) in American goods [breakfast cereals, artificial juices and candies].

[RETRACTED] Initiative 7 - No Area 51.

Initiative 17 was mistakenly numbered as Initiative 16. Therefore the correction adjusts all subsequent initiatives by an increase of 1 digit.

Initiative 17 - There must be no medical or recreational marijuana use in the United States.
Initiative 18 - Mr. Trump please remain 12 years as President.

Initiative 19 - Megalopolis such as New York City, Atlanta, Boston, Houston, Los Angeles etc. should engage in the greenhouse farming of vine-originating crops such as Tomatoes and Grapes. Such activity may encourage conservative attitudes regarding health & wellness, may reduce crime and add employment and technical know-how and bring a greater Psychological well-being all while curbing addictions.

Initiative 20 - Stop Bank Ejectment! Kindly, no bank should be allowed to transfer to state custody dormant accounts alternatively banks should carry out temporary account suspensions to prevent balance depletion due to the monthly fee.

[RETRACTED] Initiative 20 - To 20n - During this COVID-19 and Coronavirus disease crisis no bank account should be closed due to dormancy or a zero balance.

Initiative 21 - Nuclear powered automobiles must be outlawed.

Initiative 22 - In light of the Federal debt no licensed banker's Federal Reserve account should be totally exhausted at any point. Therefore banks themselves must make a partial deposit of their profits and capital cashflows into one separate Federal Reserve account than their consumer's Federal Reserve balances. In the case of mass withdrawals or calamity the bank therefore will have funds to pay its salaries/commission-based employees--some who are licensed--and be able to borrow from the treasury to weather a national hardship.

Initiative 23 - The skin of vegetables such as potatoes, potato flakes, many other vegetables like carrots and canned fruits should be left unpeeled.

Initiative 24 - With respect to the immigration crisis, farmers needing labor must receive grants and/or low-interest loans to purchase conveyor belts that can be placed near rows of vegetable- and fruit-producing trees such as corn, apple, wheat and the likes, assisting with the harvesting process in getting the crop transported to the markets and alleviating labor shortages.

Initiative 25 - No nuclear power companies in any of the 50 United States, kindly.

Initiative 26 - A Federal or State exonerated prisoner or discharged hospital detainee shall immediately receive \$3,000 dollars. One who is acquitted of municipal charges must receive \$1,500.
[RETRACTED] Initiative 27 - Trusts and wills can be filed in any county of choice instead of the county of one's legal residence.

Initiative 28 - A new Federal Vandalism act should apply not only to churches and government property but also to one's home and personal property. See 18 USC 247.

[REVISED] Initiative 29 - One who has become a registered Financial Services Rep, Financial Advisor or Registered Investment Advisor shall remain as a active search result in FINRA's broker check tool for 10 years from each effective form U4 submission.

Initiative 30 - Mr. Biden please have Congress outlaw the academic grades such as A-, B-, C- or D-. There is no mathematical backing to negatives, and use of them wastes student aid funds.

Initiative 8 - Tax Credits for the Sole Proprietor - Currently no EIC is allowed for self-employment activity as IRS Schedule C for Form 1040 does not allow credits of any sort.

Initiative 9 - Recycle All Refuse - paper, plastics, styrofoam and metal
Initiative 10 - FEMA must create a military/police/gang duress program.

Initiative 10s - civil action remedy involving military or police activity resulting in assault, dismemberment or death of a civilian or enlisted person shall carry a 15-year statute of limitations and 25-year statute of limitations for violent activity against one who is detained/incarcerated.

Initiative 10ii - With reliance on an amended war crimes statute at 18 USC 2441 US prosecutors shall have the ability to appeal an acquittal should the defendants be military or police laymen.

Initiative 10iii - The Dept. of Defense must disclose all names of active duty personnel to the public upon request.

[REVISED] Initiative 10iv - County and municipal police maintain a registry of all employed law enforcement, listing name and a physical address for service of process.

Initiative 11 - Federal Teacher's Guilds must be chartered and funded to compensate schools systems with no pupils. Teacher's Guilds will allow instructors who have achieved a Bachelor's degree or more to re-enter their former school house and earn a reduced income while engaging in solitary reading of their chosen lesson and completing all the subjects activities thus preserving multiple disciplines, the tax base, the buildings and fostering community involvement and guidance to our nation's youngsters.

Initiative 12 - This administration must reduce [actively monitor] private sector acquisition of the materials unlike in nuclear devices.

Initiative/Doctrine 13 - Kindly order that military personnel deployed to the Middle East secure oil, gas, coal fields and plants etc. instead of meandering through the cities. The troops should be no more than 1 mile away from the each plant.

Initiative 14 - No public or private building should have two unsafe exterior handles on exit/entrance doors. This presents perils because the door could be chained shut from the outside, preventing the building's occupants from exiting.

Initiative 15 - Student loan lifetime maximum of \$200,000.

Initiative 16 - Mr. Biden please initiate a Federal effort to inspect all U.S. based federal, state and private mental health hospitals and wards for instances of undue detention and murder of their patients. Further kindly implement legislation or Code of Federal Regulation directives that would permit registered Investment Advisors to receive an immediate Federal grant of 20% of their target capital-raising goal and Broker/Dealers to receive an immediate Federal grant of 80% of their target capital-raising goal for each corporate underwriting client. The Securities Act of 1933, Securities and Exchange Act of 1934 and the Investment Advisor Act of 1940 does not include language that mandates that the Federal government make grants to B/Ds and I/As. Thusly brokers are burdened with collecting and then distributing finances from individual and corporate investor accounts in order to fund initial public offerings and transactions in the secondary markets all while MORGENTHAU brokers are permitted borrow trillions from the federal government.

Initiative 32i - Without the assistance of an IA or BD may the U.S. government fund 7% of a C-corporation's grant request and 5% of a LLC grant request.

Initiative 32ii - The U.S. government must increase the number of farms responsible for the production of the crops used to create paper and currency. Kindly direct the United States Department of Treasury to increase daily U.S. dollar printing by 1,800 percent or increased by rational and target amount to meet funding schemes to meet Federal payroll, debt service demands, BD/IA underwriting/IPOs and mortgage brokers who immensely enrich themselves when 1 existing home is sold or a mortgage or automobile note is completely paid.

[RETRACTED] Initiative 35 - This initiative pertained to the IRS extending the expiration of renewable energy and solar energy tax credits.

Initiative 36 - Mr. Timothy McVegh was innocent and should receive release from his protective custody in Fairfield, Ohio. The Murray Building facade was laced with explosives.

Initiative 37 - All courts-state/county and Federal should be compelled by law to indicate in their rules that applicable statute of limitations for each type of cause of action.

Initiative 38 - May the United States should become a grower of the Banana, Mango, Papaya, Pineapple and Fig.
